**KMIDS Admission Examination Guidelines for Grade 7 - 10**  
**Academic Year 2020-2021: Round 2**

**1. Candidate Qualifications**

1.1 Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 6 (American system)
- Prathom 6 (Thai system)
- Year 7 (British system)
- Standard 4 or Year 6 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system

1.2 Grade 8:

- Grade 7 (American system)
- Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
- Year 8 (British system)
- Form 1 or Year 7 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system

1.3 Grade 9:

- Grade 8 (American system)
- Mathayom 2 (Thai system)
- Year 9 (British system)
- Form 2 or Year 8 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 8 of American system

1.4 Grade 10:

- Grade 9 (American system)
- Mathayom 3 (Thai system)
- Year 10 (British system)
- Form 3 or Year 9 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 9 of American system

**FOR ALL:**

1.5 No serious medical or emotional conditions that may affect learning

1.6 Must be proficient in written and spoken English

1.7 Should be especially interested in mathematics, science and technology

## 4. Application Fee

All candidates must pay the application fee of 5,500 baht for Grade 7, Grade 8, Grade 9 and Grade 10. This fee will cover the cost of examination and interview.

**\* Payment must be made by Friday, January 17, 2020 at 12:00 PM (noon)**

## 5. Application & Examination Procedures and Details

Every student must go through this registration process:

- 5.1 Open [www.kmids.ac.th](http://www.kmids.ac.th) and click "Admission" tab. Follow the instructions in the website. Fill in the information in the registration form. Print the registration form and pay-in slip (There will be a barcode on the pay-in slip).
- 5.2 Scan and upload the candidate's picture and an official transcript with at least the latest semester showing, according to the instructions on the website.\*
- 5.3 Bring the pay-in slip and pay at SCB counter or at a counter service of your choice. Please refer to the barcode on the pay-in slip when making payment.
- 5.4 Take a photo of the receipt as proof of payment and e-mail it to [info@kmids.ac.th](mailto:info@kmids.ac.th) with the name of the applicant shown.
- 5.5 The registration system will verify the payment and send an automatic response via e-mail.
- 5.6 The examination card will be sent on **Tuesday, January 28, 2020** (three days before the test date) via registered e-mail.

## 6. Admission Process and Details

6.1 On the examination day, candidates must present the following required documents to show proof of identity and registration:

- 1) Examination ID card which can be printed from the e-mail
- 2) A student identification card, national identification card, or other government-issued national card that has the candidate's picture. Only original documents will be accepted.
- 3) An official transcript of at least one **latest semester**. The transcript must be an original document and must be sealed (Only for those who have not uploaded the transcript onto the system)

**Candidates who cannot present complete and proper documents will be disqualified from taking the entrance examination**

6.2 Examination - To ensure that KMIDS maintains its standard of excellence, assessments (as shown below) will be used to provide a review of prospective students. These assessments are mandatory and cannot be supplemented.

6.4 All candidates must arrive at the test venue at 7.30 a.m. in order to go through the check-in process before entering the examination rooms. All candidates must be present by 8:00 to begin the examination process, or they may not participate. Application fee refunds are not given in any circumstances for a failure to attend.

6.5 Students should only bring pencils and their I.D.'s to the examination. Other materials are not permitted, including mobile devices, smart watches, etc.

## 7 Admission Status Information

7.1 The school will release the names of the candidates that have qualified for the admission process on **Wednesday, Feb 12, 2020** via [www.kmids.ac.th](http://www.kmids.ac.th). **Please note: the school will only release the names of the candidates that are qualified to enroll directly to those families, and reserves the right to keep scores or other names confidential. All decisions made by the Admission Committee are final.**

7.2 Candidates who are not accepted into the admission process in this round may register for the next round(s) of admission.

## 8 Enrollment and School Tuition and Fees Payment

8.1 Qualified candidates for King Mongkut's International Demonstration School must confirm enrollment status by making a full payment by **Monday, Feb 24, 2019**. Payment details are summarized in the table shown below.

### IMPORTANT REMARKS:

\* *School Development Fund is payable to the KMIDS Foundation.*

\*\* *New tuition rate will be applied when students enter grade 10. For example, students entering grade 8 will pay the tuition of 460,000 for two years and a new tuition fee (to be determined in the future) will be applied when they enter grade 10. Students entering grade 9 will pay the tuition of 460,000 for only one year and will have to pay a new tuition rate (to be determined in the future) when the student enters grade 10.*

\*\*\* *Main Activities fee does NOT include other activities such as Week Without Walls, Supplements and Clubs, all of which will be communicated separately later.*

\*\*\*\* *Textbook and Security Deposit will be refunded after the student leaves the school.*

### 8.2 Dormitory and Transportation Fees (If applicable)

(1) Dormitory Fee for Academic Year 2020-21 (for 10 months from mid-August until June) is 80,000 THB which includes cleaning, laundry, transportation and internet service EXCEPT meals, electricity and water fees.

(2) Transportation Fee (2-way journey to and from Ladkrabang Airport Link Station) is 23,000 THB which is the fixed rate for 2-way transport.

### 8.3 Qualified candidates and parents must be present on the enrollment date, which will be announced via the registered e-mail addressed provided to the school.

All required documents, dates and times will also be announced via the registered e-mail address.

**9. Requirements for candidates who cannot be physically present on the designated time and venue:**

- 9.1 Grade 7-8 candidates must abide to the following guidelines:
- (1) Present the TOEFL Junior, TOEFL ITP, TOEFL iBT, or IELTS results to the selection committee before **the designated test date.**
  - (2) The selection committee will appoint a date for an interview of the students and the parents before **the designated test date.**
- 9.2 Grade 9-10 candidates must abide to the following guidelines:
- (1) Present the TOEFL ITP, TOEFL iBT, or IELTS results to the selection committee before **the designated test date.**
  - (2) In the case where a candidate is abroad, please contact the school to schedule an interview and a written examination date and time. The written examination will include mathematics, general science, an aptitude test and a writing test. The candidate must go through the admission process before **the designated test date.**
  - (3) In the case where the candidate is in Thailand, the candidate must take the entrance examinations at KMIDS. Please contact the school to schedule an interview and a written examination date and time. The written examination will include mathematics, general science, an aptitude test and a writing test. The candidate must go through the admission process before **the designated test date.**
