Admission and Examination Guidelines for Grade 6 - 10 Academic Year 2023 - 2024 Round 1

1. Candidate Qualifications

1.1 Grade 6 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 5 (American system)
- Prathom 5 (Thai system)
- Year 6 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 5 of American system

1.2 Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 6 (American system)
- Prathom 6 (Thai system)
- Year 7 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system

1.3 Grade 8 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 7 (American system)
- Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
- Year 8 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system

1.4 Grade 9 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 8 (American system)
- Mathayom 2 (Thai system)
- Year 9 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 8 of American system

1.5 Grade 10 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 9 (American system)
- Mathayom 3 (Thai system)
- Year 10 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 9 of American system

FOR ALL:

- 1.6 No serious medical or emotional conditions that may affect learning
- 1.7 Must be proficient in written and spoken English
- 1.8 Should be especially interested in mathematics, science, and technology

4. Admission Fee

The application fee covering the cost of examination (standardized tests) and interview for one candidate is 5,500 baht. It is noted that the application fee must be paid at least one week prior to the admission tests.

5. Application Procedures

Every parent and student must follow the application procedures to register online for taking the entrance examination as follows.

- 5.1 Fill out an Inquiry Form online or on campus.
- 5.2 KMIDS staff will contact you and send a link to register online. Follow the instructions on the website. Fill in the information for Phase One of the registration
- 5.3 Scan and upload the required documents.
- 5.4 Pay an application fee of 5,500 baht via money transfer to the KMIDS bank account (SCB Saving Account no: 088-2-60770-1)
- 5.5 Send the payment slip to finance@kmids.ac.th and copy (CC) to admission@kmids.ac.th

6. Examination Schedule and details

After the completion of application procedures, the prospective students (candidates) are required to prepare for the examination. The details are as follows.

6.1 Examination types and schedule - To ensure that KMIDS maintains its strive for excellence, assessments (as shown below) will be used to provide a review of prospective students. These assessments are mandatory and cannot be supplemented.

*** Remarks:

1. The candidates will need to bring their own laptop (**Windows or iMac laptops are recommended**). **Please note:** We cannot support Android or iPad devices for test taking.
2. The examination time and schedule mentioned are subject to change and advised as needed due to any unexpected circumstances.

6.2 Preparation for taking examination – make sure you bring your ID, laptop, pencil with you to take the exam on 5th Nov. 2022. You need to follow the procedures on the exam date.

On the examination date, the procedures are as follows.

- Candidates arrive at the test venue at 7:30 a.m. and do the check-in process before entering the examination rooms.
- Candidates enter the exam room at 8:00 a.m. (Please be noted that the candidates are not allowed to enter the room after the time specified and the application fee cannot be refunded).
- Candidates are allowed to take only their own laptops and pencils for writing and filling the answers into the exam room. Other items such as pens, wristwatches, cellphones, and other electronic devices are not permitted.

7. Enrollment and School Tuition Fees

Qualified candidates for KMIDS must confirm the enrollment student status by making a full payment by **Monday, 19 December 2022**. Payment details are summarized in the table shown below.

Dormitory Fee and Transportation Fee:

7.1 Dormitory fees (If applicable) for Academic Year 2023-2024 (for 10 months from mid-August until June) are 130,000 THB which includes dormitory activities, cleaning, laundry, transportation, breakfast, dinner, electricity, water and internet services.

7.2 Transportation Fee (If applicable) is a 2-way journey to and from Ladkrabang Airport Link Station. The transportation fee is 23,000 THB which is a fixed rate for 2-way transport for the year according to the school calendar.

Foundation Course in July:

Foundation Course fee is 35,000 THB (Including Lunch and Snacks) for students who pass an examination with the condition.

A KMIDS applicant IS NOT CONSIDERED a student at KMIDS until the registration and enrollment process is completed. Final registration and enrollment will take place on or near the 1st day of school when the student signs the official “KMIDS Enrollment Form”. Also, the student will need to submit all important documents, such as the updated transcript, physical examination, health record, enrollment form, etc. on the “Documents Submission Day.” Parents will be notified about the important dates by email that they have registered on the online application.
