KMIDS Admission Examination Guidelines for Grade 6 - 10 Academic Year 2023 - 2024 Round 2

1. Candidate Qualifications

- 1.1 Grade 6 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 5 (American system)
 - Prathom 5 (Thai system)
 - Year 6 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 5 of American system
- 1.2 Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 6 (American system)
 - Prathom 6 (Thai system)
 - Year 7 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system
- 1.3 Grade 8 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 7 (American system)
 - Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
 - Year 8 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system
- 1.4 Grade 9 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 8 (American system)
 - Mathayom 2 (Thai system)
 - Year 9 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 8 of American system
- 1.5 Grade 10 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 9 (American system)
 - Mathayom 3 (Thai system)
 - Year 10 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 9 of American system

FOR ALL:

- 1.6 No serious medical or emotional conditions that may affect learning
- 1.7 Must be proficient in written and spoken English
- 1.8 Should be especially interested in mathematics, science and technology

4. Admission Fee

All candidates must pay the admission fee of 5,500 baht for Grade 6, Grade 7, Grade 8, Grade 9 and Grade 10. This fee will cover the cost of the examination and interview. The application fee must be paid at least one week prior to the admission tests.

5. Application & Examination Procedures and Details

Every parent and student must go through this registration process:

5.1 Fill out an inquiry form online or on campus

5.2 Once KMIDS receive your form, we will contact you and send a link to apply online.

Follow the instructions on the website. Fill in the information for Phase One of the registration

5.3 Scan and upload the required documents.

5.4 Pay an application fee of 5,500 baht via money transfer to the KMIDS bank account (SCB Saving Account no: 088-2-60770-1)

5.5 Send the payment slip to finance@kmids.ac.th and copy admission@kmids.ac.th

6. Examination

To ensure that KMIDS strives for excellence, the various types of examinations are provided (as shown in the table below). The assessment is proceeded with a group of qualified committees of KMIDs to select our prospective students. Please be noted that every candidate is required to take the examination. There is no exception.

***** Remarks:**

1. The candidates will need to bring their own laptops (**Windows or iMac laptops are recommended**). **Please note:** Since the online examination systems are not compatible with Android tablets or iPad, the candidates cannot use such devices for test taking.
2. The examination time and schedule mentioned are subject to change and advised as needed due to any unexpected circumstances.

On the examination date, the procedures are as follows.

- Candidates arrive at the test venue at 7:30 a.m. and do the check-in process before entering the examination rooms.
- Candidates enter the exam rooms at 8:00 a.m. (Please be noted that the candidates are not allowed to enter the room after the time specified and the application fee cannot be refunded.)
- Candidates are allowed to take only their own laptops and pencils for writing and filling the answers into the exam room. Other items such as pens, wristwatches, cellphones, and other electronic devices are not permitted.

7. Enrollment and School Tuition Fees Payment

Qualified candidates for KMIDS must confirm the enrollment student status by making a full payment by **Friday, 27 January 2023**. Payment details are summarized in the table shown below.

- * *School Development Fund is payable to the KMIDS Foundation. It is non-refundable.*
 - ** *Main Activities fee does NOT include other activities such as Week Without Walls, Supplements or Clubs, all of which will be communicated separately later.*
 - *** *Textbook and Security deposit will be refunded after the student leaves the school.*
- All fees are subject to change without prior notice.*

7.2 Dormitory Fee and Transportation Fee:

- 7.2.1 Dormitory fees (If applicable) for Academic Year 2023-2024 (for 10 months from mid-August until June) are 130,000 THB which includes dormitory activities, cleaning, laundry, transportation, breakfast, dinner, electricity, water, and internet services.
- 7.2.2 Transportation Fee (If applicable) is a 2-way journey to and from Ladkrabang Airport Link Station. The transportation fee is 23,000 THB which is a fixed rate for 2-way transport for the year as according to the school calendar.

7.3 Foundation Course in July:

Foundation Course fee (if applicable) is 35,000 THB which includes tuition fee, lunch and snacks for students who pass an examination with the condition.

- Please note that a KMIDS applicant IS NOT CONSIDERED a student at KMIDS until the registration and enrollment process is completed.
- Final registration and enrollment will take place on or near the 1st day of school when the student signs the official “KMIDS Enrollment Form”.
- The student will need to submit all important documents, such as the updated transcript, physical examination, health record, enrollment form, etc. on the “Documents Submission Day.”
- Parents will be notified about the important dates by email that they have registered on the online application.
