**KMIDS Admission Examination Guidelines for Grade 6 - 10
Academic Year 2023 - 2024 Round 3**

1. Candidate Qualifications

- 1.1 Grade 6 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 5 (American system)
 - Prathom 5 (Thai system)
 - Year 6 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 5 of American system
- 1.2 Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 6 (American system)
 - Prathom 6 (Thai system)
 - Year 7 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system
- 1.3 Grade 8 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 7 (American system)
 - Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
 - Year 8 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system
- 1.4 Grade 9 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 8 (American system)
 - Mathayom 2 (Thai system)
 - Year 9 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 8 of American system
- 1.5 Grade 10 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:
- Grade 9 (American system)
 - Mathayom 3 (Thai system)
 - Year 10 (British system)
 - Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 9 of American system

FOR ALL:

- 1.6 Must have **No** serious medical or emotional conditions that may affect learning.
1.7 Must be proficient in written and spoken English.
1.8 Should be especially interested in mathematics, science, and technology.

4. Admission Fee

All candidates must pay the admission fee of 5,500 baht for Grade 6, Grade 7, Grade 8, Grade 9 and Grade 10. This fee will cover the cost of the examination and interview. The admission fee must be paid at least one week prior to the admission tests.

5. Procedures for Application and Examination

Since KMIDS utilizes the standardized online tests for assessing our prospective students, the candidates are required to go through this application process for taking the tests as follows.

- 5.1 Fill out an inquiry form online or on campus to receive the online link for application.
- 5.2 Follow the instructions on the website to apply for the tests. Fill in the necessary information for Phase One of the registration and prepare the required documents.
- 5.3 Scan and upload the required documents.
- 5.4 Pay an admission fee of 5,500 baht via money transfer to the KMIDS bank account (SCB Saving Account no: 088-2-60770-1).
- 5.5 Send the payment slip to finance@kmids.ac.th and copy admission@kmids.ac.th

6. Examination

To ensure that KMIDS maintains its strive for excellence, MAP® (Measures of Academic Progress®) Tests and Interview are our assessments tools to examine our prospective students. **These assessments are mandatory and cannot be supplemented.**

Remarks:

1. Test Takers will need to bring their own laptop (**Windows or iMac laptops are recommended.**) Please note: We cannot support Android or iPad devices for test taking.
2. The examination time and schedule mentioned are subject to change and advised as needed due to any unexpected circumstances.

On the examination date, the procedures are as follows.

- Candidates arrive at the test venue at 7:30 a.m. and do the check-in process before entering the examination rooms.
- Candidates enter the exam room at 8:00 a.m. (Please be noted that the candidates are not allowed to enter the room after the time specified and the application fee cannot be refunded.).
- Candidates are allowed to take only their own laptops and pencils for writing and filling the answers into the exam room. Other items such as pens, wristwatches, cellphones, and other electronic devices are not permitted.

7. Enrollment, School Tuition Fee and Other Fees Payment**Enrollment**

After the result announcement, to reserve the place at KMIDS, the qualified candidates should contact the Admission Office to confirm the enrollment student status by making a full payment by **Friday, 9 June 2023**.

Tuition fee and other fees have been approved by the board of directors in the Announcement of KMIDS about tuition fee and other fees for the academic year 2023.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- * School Development Fund is payable to the KMIDS Foundation. It is non-refundable.
- ** Main Activities fee does NOT include other activities such as Week Without Walls, Supplements or Clubs, all of which will be communicated separately later.
- *** Textbook and Security deposit will be refunded after the student leaves the school.
- **** All fees are subject to change without prior notice.

Dormitory Fee and Transportation Fee

- Dormitory fee (If applicable) for Academic Year 2023-2024 (for 10 months from mid August 2023 until June 2024) are 130,000 THB which includes accommodation, cleaning, laundry, transportation, meals (breakfast and dinner), electricity, water, internet services, and dormitory activities.
- Transportation fee (If applicable) is a 2-way journey to and from Ladkrabang Airport Link Station. The transportation fee is 23,000 THB which is a fixed rate for 2-way transport for the year as according to the school calendar.

Foundation Course in July

Foundation Course fee is 35,000 THB (Including Lunch and Snacks) for students who pass an examination with the condition.

A KMIDS applicant IS NOT CONSIDERED a student at KMIDS until the registration and enrollment process is completed. Final registration and enrollment will take place on or near the 1st day of school when the student signs the official "KMIDS Enrollment Form". Also, the student will need to submit all important documents, such as the updated transcript, physical examination, health record, enrollment form, etc. on the "Documents Submission Day". Parents will be notified about the important dates by email that they have registered on the online application.
