KMIDS Admission Examination Guidelines for Grade 6 - 8 Academic Year 2024 - 2025 Round 1

1. Candidate Qualifications

1.1) Grade 6 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 5 (American system)
- Prathom 5 (Thai system)
- Year 6 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 5 of American system

1.2) Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 6 (American system)
- Prathom 6 (Thai system)
- Year 7 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system

1.3) Grade 8 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade levels:

- Grade 7 (American system)
- Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
- Year 8 (British system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system

FOR ALL:

1.4) No serious medical or emotional conditions that may affect learning.

1.5) Must be proficient in written and spoken English.

1.6) Should be especially interested in mathematics, science, and technology.

3. Admission Fee and Procedure

3.1) The application fee covering the cost of examination (standardized tests) and interview for one candidate is 5,500 baht. It is noted that the application fee must be paid at least one week prior to the admission tests.

3.2) Application Procedure:

The admission officer will ask you to follow the steps below.

- 3.1.1 Fill out an application form online or on campus. (Please note that your active email address is needed.)
- 3.1.2 The admission officer will contact you via email and send a link to apply for the examination online. Follow the instructions on the website. Fill in the information for phase one of the registration.
- 3.1.3 Scan and upload the required documents.
- 3.1.4 Pay an admission fee of 5,500 baht via money transfer to the KMIDS bank account (SCB Saving Account no: 088-2-60770-1).
- 3.1.5 Send the payment slip to finance@kmids.ac.th and CC admission@kmids.ac.th

4. Examination

To ensure that KMIDS maintains its strive for excellence, MAP® (Measures of Academic Progress®) Tests and Interview are our assessment tools to examine our prospective students. **These assessments are mandatory and cannot be supplemented.**

Remarks:

1. Test Takers will need to bring their own laptop (**Windows or iMac laptops are recommended.**) **Please note:** We cannot support Android or iPad devices for test taking.
2. The examination time and schedule mentioned are subject to change and advised as needed due to any unexpected circumstances.

On the examination date, the procedures are as follows.

- Candidates arrive at the test venue at 7:30 a.m. and do the check-in process before entering the examination rooms.
- Candidates enter the exam room at 8:00 a.m. (Please be noted that the candidates are not allowed to enter the room after the time specified and the application fee cannot be refunded.).
- Candidates are allowed to take only their own laptops and pencils for writing and filling the answers into the exam room. Other items such as pens, wristwatches, cellphones, and other electronic devices are not permitted.

5. Enrollment, School Tuition Fee and Other Fees Payment

5.1) Enrollment and School Tuition and Fees Payment

After the results announcement, the qualified candidates should confirm their enrollment student status by making payment within the due date of payment for each round. Payment details are summarized in the table shown below.

IMPORTANT:

- 1) The Main Activities fee does NOT include other activities such as Field Trips, Supplements or Clubs, all of which will be communicated separately later.
- 2) All fees are subject to change without prior notice.

Other Fees (if applicable)

- Dormitory fee (If applicable) for Academic Year 2024 - 2025 (for 10 months from mid-August until June) is 120,000 THB which includes accommodation, dormitory activities, cleaning, laundry, transportation, breakfast, dinner, electricity, water, and internet services.
- Transportation Fee (If applicable) is a 2 - way journey to and from Ladkrabang Airport Link station. The transportation fee is 30,000 THB which is a fixed rate for 2 - way transport for the year according to the school calendar.
- ROTC (Military Training for male students in Grade 10-12) cost in different Grade level as following:
 - For Grade 10, it costs 8,000 THB including the uniforms and registration fee.
 - For Grade 11-12, it costs 2,000 THB including the registration fee only.
 - School vans are optional: 3,000 THB

6. Preparation for new students who pass exams with conditions.

There will be a foundation course to prepare new students who pass the exam with conditions. This is to ensure their readiness for taking regular courses in school.

6.1) Foundation Course in July:

Foundation Course fee is 35,000 THB (Including lunch and snacks) for students who pass an examination with the condition.

Please note that: A KMIDS applicant IS NOT CONSIDERED a student at KMIDS until the registration and enrollment process is completed. Final registration and enrollment will take place on or near the 1st day of school when the student signs the official "KMIDS Enrollment Form". Also, the student will need to submit all important documents, such as the updated transcript, physical examination, health record, enrollment form, etc. on the "Documents Submission Day". Parents will be notified about the important dates by email that they have registered on the online application.
